John and Kate have been wonderful supporters of Mitchelstown Cope Centre.

At Con's funeral his brother John spoke touching words of appreciation to all who made Con's life so happy and fulfilled at Mitchelstown Cope Centre. Con's passing is an opportunity to thank all the volunteers and benefactors of Mitchelstown Cope. It is a fabulous centre and the staff there, are absolutely fantastic.

At the moment a volunteer committee is building a Sensory Garden adjacent to the centre, again the selfless giving of so many people is an inspiration. Con will be greatly missed by the staff and residents. Con spoke very little, but he had a wonderful smile and very curious nature, which endeared him to all who knew him. The comment of many people at his funeral was that while Con may have been limited in his ability, he brought out the best in all who knew and cared for him.

The Cope Foundation developed from what was once known as Cork Polio. They give fantastic support to young men and women with special needs and to their families. Like all organisations of care today, they need the support of the community and they are a most worthy cause.

The funeral Mass of Con ended with the beautiful song of Phil Coulter: "Scorn not his simplicity, but love him all the more". At the end of the prayers at the graveside the staff and residents sang Con's favourite song: "The Banks of my own lovely Lee".
