Many consider the Lough Derg Pilgrimage as the best of all pilgrimages. Many peop come from all over the world to do the pilgrimage, they come from all background and professions. While the pilgrimage involves fasting from food, sleep and doing the exercises in ones bare feet, having done the pilgrimage many state they feel a great sense of freedom and purification. Our Lord Himself teaches us that the great weapon against evil in the world is fasting and prayer.
