On Our Journey To Heaven:

As we enter the special month of November, we remind ourselves to be aware that our life is short and passing. We focus on the Gospel promise on the gift of life eternal in the world to come. We contemplate the saints who have reached that place of glory and we offer prayer and sacrifice for our brothers and sisters on their way there, through the purification of purgatory. From the earliest days of the Christian religion, the Church has honoured with great respect, the memory of the dead. Principal among the devout acts of the God's people for the dead is the celebration of the Holy Sacrifice of the Eucharist, prayers offered for the dead, alms deeds, works of mercy and the application of indulgences to the souls of the faithful departed.

What are Indulgences?

Indulgences are the remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven. The faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains the indulgence under prescribed conditions for either himself or the departed. Indulgences are granted through the ministry of the Church which, as the dispenser of the grace of redemption, distributes the treasury of the merits of Christ and the Saints.

Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

- 1. From 12 o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, and prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.
 - This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1^{st} November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1^{st} November to 8^{th} November.
- 2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.

Lord God,

Whose days are without end and whose mercies are beyond counting,
Keep us mindful that life is short and the hour of death unknown.

Let your Spirit guide our days on earth in the ways of holiness and justice,
that we may serve you in union with the whole Church,
Sure in faith, strong in hope, perfect in love.
And when our earthly journey is ended,
lead us rejoicing into your kingdom,

Where you live forever and ever. Amen.
