URGENT REPLY NEEDED:

Tax Refund System: Grateful thanks to all who have replied regarding qualification for the tax refund system. Unfortunately, there are still a number of you we have not heard from. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT ALL OF YOU, REPLY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. WE CANNOT SEND OFF OUR APPLICATION FOR TAX REFUND WITHOUT GETTING A REPLY FROM EACH AND EVERYONE OF YOU WHO HAVE RECEIVED DOCUMENTATION FROM THE PARISH OFFICE.

This is our 1st year claiming back the tax on PAYE donations, so we need to know what category you fall into, such as, Pensioner, Self-employed, PAYE or Not Eligible for Tax. Your reply will greatly help the Parish administration and eliminate the need of sending out unnecessary correspondence to you in the future.
