CARD DRIVE TO PROTECT ELDERLY FROM ROGUE TRADERS

GARDAI took to the streets of
Mitchelstown this week in a bid to
highlight the issue of rogue traders
operating in the north Cork region.
Members of the force joined with local
groups, including Blackwater
Community Connect, to hand out
cards to elderly people offering advice
on how to deal with unsolicited callers
to their homes. On the back of each
card is a list of points containing advice
on what to do when a stranger calls to
your front door.

These include ensuring that the latch is in place and not engaging suspicious characters in conversation. The cards can be handed to the caller who will be asked to write down their details, which can then be checked out by local Gardai. Fermoy based inspector Tony O'Sullivan said that these simple yet effective measures could make all the difference, particularly to elderly people living in isolated and rural areas.

"We are concerned at the rise in the number of rogue traders operating within not only our area but the whole of Cork. It is also our belief that many incidents are not reported to Gardai out of embarrassment," said the inspector. "If a caller is genuine he or she will not mind leaving their details. If they are reluctant to do so then that should also be reported to Gardai," he added.
