This service is provided on a voluntary basis by members of our community who recognise the need for this service and want to help solve the problem. Liam's Lifts is running in the Fermoy / Mitchelstown area and we hope to be in a position to expand throughout North Cork in the future. **How it works?** To ensure that our passengers have the least level of disruption, we collect each passenger from their own home.
