We hope this will give greater security to Church property and to the property of all who come to worship and pray in the Church, alone or for various liturgical events. Parish Pastoral Council: On Monday last the P.P.C. held its 1st meeting in the Town Hall of this, the 3rd& final year of this Councils term. The Council committed itself again to continue to reach out and to help develop the faith life of the Parish. The Council has undertaken to help prepare a monthly Family Mass on the last Sunday of each month, this will be the 11.30am Mass. Families are already participating at the Ballygiblin & Killacluig Sunday Masses. We will begin in the Parish Church on Sunday, September 24th.

When this 3rd year of this 3 year term of Council ends in June 2018, a number of this present Council will retire, so in the intervening period the Parish will be seeking new nominations to replace them. We will be explaining the procedure in the coming months. The Constitution envisages the Council being renewed every three years, new faces and new ideas, while retaining a number of the members of the previous Council.

Annual Collection for the Education of Priests:

- •While this year the Diocese of Cloyne does not have any students preparing for priesthood, however, we are engaged with some young men who are discerning their vocation.
- •We have one priest studying for a doctorate in theology and others doing ongoing education.
- •The Diocese is greatly blessed with the forthcoming Ordination to the Permanent Diaconate of six men, who have been in formation for the last four years. This Ordination ceremony will take place in St. Colman's Cathedral, Cobh on September 24th at 2.30pm. All are welcome.
- The Diocese has 3 other candidates for the Permanent Diaconate who are in their final year of formation. The overall cost of this formation is €40,000 per annum.
- •The promotion of vocations to the priesthood and religious life must always be a priority of the whole Church. It is so important for families and parishes to pray for and support those considering priesthood or religious life. Such new vocations are the seeds from which the future of the Church will grow.
