Children's Adoration:

An introductory session of "Children's Eucharistic Adoration" will be held in Town Hall on Friday, November 15th from 4.15pm to 5.30pm, facilitated Antoinette Moynihan of "Children of the Eucharist". This is aimed at Primary Scho Children and is of particular benefit to those preparing for First Holy Communion Confirmation. This initiative, in operation since October 2012, arising out of International Eucharistic Congress, is currently growing from strength to streng around the country and is proving very popular with children, providing them with lovely way to relax in front of the Lord, through prayer, story and song. Venerable Nano:

Nano Nagle, who founded the Presentation Sisters, was declared venerable by Pope Francis on Thursday, October 31st 2013. It is the 2nd stage on the way to beatification and canonization. As a young woman, she gave herself to the care and education of the poor of Cork city. She set up her first school in Cave Lane, Cork in 1754 and founded the Presentation Sisters 20 years later. Born in Ballygriffin, Killavullen in 1718 and died of tuberculosis, April 26th 1784. As her legacy she bequeathed to her sisters the treasure which she prized above all the wealth of the earth, the love of the poor of Jesus Christ. She encouraged her Sisters "spend yourself for the poor".

Mitchelstown and the surrounding area are indebted to her for the work her sisters did among us for over 150 years. May she intercede for us.
