In recognition of the great contribution that grandparents make to the Church, to family, and to society in teaching and passing on the faith, Mitchelstown Parish Pastoral Council have organised that the 11.30am Mass in the Parish Church, Mitchelstown on Sunday 9th September will be a celebration for grandparents and families.

A Special Time: The month of August is a month of special Feasts dedicated to Our Lady. This week we celebrate the moment Our Lady left this earth and was taken Body and Soul from this earth to the throne of God in Heaven. The Feast of the Assumption of Our Lady into Heaven is celebrated every year on August 15th and all Catholics are obliged to attend Mass on this special day.
