Envelope Collection System.

As I mentioned to you at Mass last Sunday, a number of Parishes throughout the Diocese and the Country are now claiming a Tax Refund on Parishioners offerings to the various church collections. This applies when a PAYE worker donates a minimum of €250 through all the various collections throughout the year.

In order to operate the system it is necessary to introduce the Envelope System. This means that <u>all</u> collections in the parish will be by way of your <u>personal envelope</u>. For confidentiality, each envelope will be numbered, rather than having your name on it. Therefore it is important that you <u>only</u> use the envelope provided for your <u>household</u>, rather than just any envelope. Ideally, the PAYE person in the house should be regarded as representing the contributions for that household.

Should other members of the household be attending separate Masses that is no problem. Just one person brings along the envelope and the others need not feel at all embarrassed at not placing a contribution in the basket. Of course for one reason or another, your contribution is not included in an envelope, your individual donations without an envelope, as heretofore, will always be welcome as the basket is being passed around.

I believe it is a successful & worthwhile system. I hope to introduce it on January 1st, 2010.
