Pope Paul VI and Bishop Oscar Romero to be Canonised: On this Sunday October 14th, Pope Paul VI who died in August 6th 1978 and Bishop Oscar Romero from El Salvador, who was murdered on March 24th 1981, while celebrating Mass. These two men gave their lives for Christ in different ways, they were sincere in their service, persevered in their love and were courageous in their decisions. May they intercede for us and for the Church at this time.

Archbishop Oscar Romero Prayer: A Step Along The Way: We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is God's work. Nothing we do is complete, which is another way of saying that the kingdom always lies beyond us. No statement says all that could be said. No prayer fully expresses our faith. No confession brings perfection. No pastoral visit brings wholeness. No programme accomplishes the church's mission. No set of goals and objectives includes everything. This is what we are about: We plant seeds that one day will grow. We water seeds already planted, knowing that they hold future promise. We lay foundations that will need further development. We provide yeast that produces effects beyond our capabilities. We cannot do everything and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something, and to do it very well. It maybe incomplete, but it is a beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for Lord's grace to enter and do the rest. We may never see the end results, but that is the difference between the master builder and the worker. We are workers, not master builders, ministers, not messiahs. We are prophets of a future not our own. Amen
