Four Sons of a Mitchelstown who Fought in World War I..... & survived' Mitchelstown Heritage Society opens its annual lecture series next Thursday October 19th at 8pm in the Mitchelstown Town Hall. Native son of Mitchelstown; Archdeacon Gerard Casey will give a talk on his relatives; the O'Sullivan brothers who joined the New Zealand army and fought in, and survived, World War I. Archdeacon Casey will be known to many as the former PP of Mallow and Doneraile parishes, his father was Liam Casey of Railway Road managed the Mart on Georges St. for years. The book 'A Diary & History of 1914-1918, four brothers went, four came back', was written by Archdeacon Casey's New Zealand cousin Kathleen Julian and published in Ireland by Archdeacon Casey. The subjects of the book were sons of an emigrant from the Mitchelstown area- Thomas O'Sullivan, the son of William O'Sullivan and Kate O'Gorman, emigrated to New Zealand from his home in Carriganleigh, Mitchelstown, where members of the O'Sullivan family still farm to this day. Based on the accounts of the war in the diaries they kept has resulted in this remarkable book of their memories of combat with the Allies in the New Zealand Expeditionary Force. This fascinating public lecture is suitable for all ages, there is a small cover charge of €5 for Society Members, €7 for the general public, all funds are going towards the Heritage Society's proposed Mitchelstown War Memorial which they propose to unveil next year.
