The Referendum:

People are asking what should we vote on the Marriage Referendum. The Irish Catholic Bishops Conference statement reminds us that, marriage down the ages has consistently held that marriage is a union of man and woman, open to the procreation of children, it is a gift of God. The Bishops guidance to us is that they cannot support an amendment to the Constitution that will put the union of two men or two women on a par with a marriage relationship between a husband and wife which is open to the procreation of children.

What we must also ask ourselves is, will the passing of this referendum seriously affect a child's right to and knowledge of his/her father and mother? Already, in The Children and Family Relationships Act 2015, it is proposed to remove mention of mothers and fathers from a whole raft of previous legislation.

One gay man writing publicly during the referendum said, "This referendum isn't about signals or about feelings or being nice to people like me, it is about family law and children". There will be many other serious consequences as well and this is why the Bishops are asking us to reflect carefully on this very serious issue. A copy of their statement is available on your way out of Mass.
