Garda Tony Golden: While many were enjoying the Rugby World Cup match of Ireland against France last Sunday evening, a great evil act was unfolding in the home of a quiet country village of Omeath, Co. Down. A young twenty-four year old man, Adrian Craven Mackin, violently shot and injured his girlfriend Siobhán (age 21) and then shot dead Garda Tony Golden (age 36) husband of Nicola and father of two young girls and a little boy, all under 8. The young man then killed himself. His girlfriend, and mother of his two young children, is now fighting for her life. The couple, Adrian & Siobhán, were in an unhappy and violent relationship and Garda Golden was protecting Siobhán when the terrible evil deed happened. An unhappy and disturbed young man, Adrian Craven Mackin, has brought untold sorry and heartbreak to many adults and children, and shaken Irish society generally.

All concerned are most especially in our prayers this weekend. May Christ, who suffered the cruel death of the Crucifixion bring the light of His Resurrection to this cruel act of darkness and evil. This degeneration of our society is a deep concern and worry to us all. We all need to work with greater urgency to address our own problems of insecurity. We need to provide every support for our families and family members and as a society to be alert in addressing the evil influences that led to the evil deed of last Sunday evening.

Garda Golden did everything he should and could have done in the circumstances and he and his family have paid a very high price. May the loss of his precious life be a new incentive to us all to be more diligent in caring for our own families and let us all work for a safer society and community and help individuals who are drifting into a dangerous place.
