World Migrant and Refugee This Sunday, 19th January 2014: Between 2004 and 2011, over half (55.2%) of 42,525 registered migrant workers in Northern Ireland were from Poland, followed by Lithuania (18.8%) and Slovakia (13.3%). Nearly two-thirds (62%) were male and just over three-quarters (77%) were aged 18-34 years. (Northern Irish Assembly 2012). Figures released by the Central Statistics Office in August 2013, estimate that in the 12 months to April 2013, overall emigration increased to 89,000 and 57% (50,900) of those who emigrated were Irish Nationals. During this period 21,900 people emigrated to the UK; 6,200 emigrated to the US; 25,700 emigrated to the EU; 15,400 emigrated to Australia; 5,300 emigrated to Canada; and 14,400 emigrated to the 'Rest of the World'.
