Blessed John O'Sullivan 1861-1933: Fr. John O'Sullivan was Beatified (declared blessed), at a Mass in the Jesuit Church, Gardiner St., Dublin on Saturday last. It was the first ever beatification ceremony to be held in Ireland. Blessed John was born into a mixed marriage, his mother being Catholic and his father Protestant. John was baptised into the Protestant faith, as was the custom for boys to follow their father. Blessed John had a 'comfortable' upbringing and was well educated and a good scholar. He studied law and the classics at Trinity College, Dublin and he also studied in London and travelled a lot. He loved cycling, walks and nature. At the age of 35 in 1896, he became a Catholic and four years later joined the Jesuits. After Ordination he was appointed as a teacher in the Jesuit Clongowes Wood College in Co. Kildare. He was a man of deep prayer, with an exceptional love for the poor and sick. He reached out to the afflicted and became known for his healing prayers over the sick. Both during his life and since his death, a number of miracles are attributed to his blessing and prayers. The miracle required and accepted for his beatification, was the cure of a woman with a cancerous tumour in her neck in 1954. The Beatification of Blessed John is a good news story for the Catholic Church in Ireland and reminds us of the good done by Catholic Priests and people down the generations. It is reliably recorded that Blessed John preached a mission in Mitchelstown Parish Church and also preached a retreat to the Presentation Sisters in the old Convent. We ask blessed John to intercede for us all and especially for our sick and troubled at this time.
