

2nd November: NORMS FOR INDULGENCES AT THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS.

- . From 12 noon on 1st Nov. until midnight on 2nd Nov. all who have confessed, received Holy Communion, & prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father & Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a Church or Oratory, & there reciting one Our Father & the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st Nov. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st Nov. to 8th Nov.
- The faithful who visit a cemetery & pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th Nov. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
