#### 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday Devotions:

On the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of every month, special devotions are held in the Parish Church after the 10 a.m. Mass. This Devotion was requested by Our Lady in Fatima in 1917. She said to the little children, Lucia, Jacinta & Francesco that God wished to establish in the world, Devotion to Her Immaculate Heart. In a later apparition to Lucia, December 10<sup>th</sup> 1925, Our Lady said "Look at My Heart surrounded with the thorns with which ungrateful men pierce it at every moment, by their blasphemies and ingratitude. You at least, try to console Me, and say that I promise to assist at the hour of death with all the graces necessary for salvation all those who, on the First Saturday of five consecutive months, go to confession and receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary and keep Me company for a quarter of an hour while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary with the intention of making reparation to Me".

The following are examples of offences against Our Lady: denial of her Immaculate Conception, denial of Her Virginity, denial of Her Divine Maternity, disrespect for Her Statues and images & downgrading of devotion to Her, especially among children.
