<u>2nd November – Norms for Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls</u>

- 1. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following $1^{\rm st}$ November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from $1^{\rm st}$ November to $8^{\rm th}$ November.
- The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
