#### **Time to Gather – Time to Prepare:**

A young Australian Cricketer in his 20's was struck by a ball on the playing field during the week, he collapsed and died a couple of days later. The Gospel, this 1st Sunday of Advent, is short, but its message is crisp: "Stay Awake", because we never know when the time will come. The time, of course, is when the Lord calls us from this world to judgement.

Throughout the world great emphasis is placed on buying presents and preparing the Christmas Feast. Let us remind ourselves that all these things satisfy our material cravings and pleasures, but our hearts are made for a deeper purpose, that is: to love God and to make a place in our hearts for His Son, Jesus. So, let us take the call of God's word seriously this 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Advent and dedicate a part of everyday, this Advent, to the Lord in prayer. Let us gather in our homes and in groups, with our neighbours and friends, to pray and really prepare to celebrate the coming of Our Saviour and King, Jesus Christ.

Satan wants to be king of our hearts and of our world, but his kingdom is deceptive, because he is the orchestrator of suffering and misery – his kingdom is going to collapse and so too all those who follow him.

We turn to Our Lady this Advent, because God has given her the power to destroy Satan and all that he is doing to destroy humanity. May, the Mother of our Saviour, help us to come close to her Son this Advent, that we may deeply experience His Joy and Love and that the reign of Jesus will be re-established in the world.

We thank you for your co-operation. As you will understand, the safety of our children is an urgent matter.
