Unforgettable Lent 2013: Lent 2013 was about to begin when Pope Benedict dropped a bombshell on us all and on the whole world. He announced on the morning of February, 11<sup>th</sup>, Feast of Our Lady Lourdes, (world day of the sick), that he was going to retire on February, 28th, as he didn't feel well enough to continue to lead the Church. At almost 86 years of age, the world understood his decision, even though he was the 1<sup>st</sup> Pope to retire in 600 years. After a very dignified farewell to Benedict, he retired to a life, of what he called, solitude and prayer for the Church and the world. Then the work of the College of Cardinals began to deliberate on electing his successor. On March 12<sup>th</sup> they entered Conclave (with key) and by the evening of Wednesday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, they sent out white smoke that they had elected a new Pope. Again, another bombshell, an Argentinean Cardinal Bergoglio was presented on the balcony of St. Peter's as Pope Francis. On March 19th, the Feast of St. Joseph, Pope Francis, was formally inaugurated. The new Pope has dedicated himself, like Christ, to the poor, in word and deed. On the balcony of St. Peter's he bowed in silence, to ask for the blessing of the people and then he gave his own blessing. The media of the world carried these extraordinary events. Many can sense a great change has taken place before our very eyes. Christ is Risen, darkness has been conquered.

Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska: On one occasion, I heard these words: My daughter, tell the whole world about My Inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy. (Diary 699)

"I was a Boy in Belsen"- a child's amazing survival of Hell on earth! What does it take to survive a Nazi Concentration Camp; hell on earth, when over six million others perished?? Find out the amazing story of survival from Holocaust survivor Tomi Reichental when he speaks to Mitchelstown Heritage Society. The lecture is on in The Firgrove Hotel, Mitchelstown, Thursday April, 4<sup>th</sup> at 8pm.
