A New Year Beginning: The challenge of the Gospel for us all is to love God first and before all. What that will cost us, is for each of us to make time in our daily demands for prayer. If we are to follow the Lord and have a living faith, we must make time for daily prayer. The Gospel of Luke often reminds us that Jesus spent a lot of time in prayer. It was while at prayer, after His baptism, that the Gospel tells us today that Heaven opened, the Holy Spirit descended upon him and the Voice of His Father was heard. We all struggle with distractions from time spent in prayer, but it is the most important exercise of the day. We depend on God, we must never forget it. May the Lord grant all of us the grace of prayer throughout 2019.

Christian Unity Service: Theme: Justice and only justice you shall pursue (Deut 16:18-20). The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2019 has been prepared by Christians from Indonesia. With a population of 265 million, about 10 per cent of Indonesians are Christian from various traditions. There is a great diversity of ethnicity, language and religion. There are also tensions affecting politics, business, justice, wealth and poverty. Christian communities in such an environment become newly aware of their unity as they join in a common concern and a common response to an unjust reality. At the same time, confronted by these injustices, we are obliged, as Christians, to examine the ways in which we are complicit. Only be heeding Jesus' prayer 'that they all may be one' can we witness to living unity in diversity. It is through our unity in Christ that we will be able to combat injustice and serve the needs of its victims. This year the prayer service will take place in the Parish Church on Monday January 21st at 7.30pm. We ask you all to make a special effort to attend and to keep the date in your diary.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF EASTER: The season of Christmas ends with the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. As the season draws to an end, the solemnity of the Epiphany offers an opportunity to proclaim the centrality of Christ's paschal mystery: dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life. The Easter Triduum or the Passion, death and Resurrection of Christ is the culmination of the entire liturgical year. Know, dear brothers and sisters that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Saviour. On the twenty-first day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the second day of June will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the ninth day of June, the feast of Pentecost.

On the twenty-third day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the first day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, To whom is honour and glory for ever and ever.
