"Three Sacred Hours" Today we begin Holy Week and we relive in a special way all that the Lord Jesus has done for us and done for love of each one of us. Despite the many distractions in our modern Ireland, keep these three days Holy this week: Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Holy Saturday. Attend Mass of the Lords Supper on Holy Thursday evening, Adore the Cross of Jesus on Good Friday and participate in the Easter Vigil of the Resurrection of Jesus on Holy Saturday night. These are three most sacred hours of the Church's whole liturgical calendar. As a Christian and as a Christian family, these three hours are the foundation of our faith. There are many kinds of parties and celebrations planned to celebrate Easter, but they have inferior joy and meaning, without re-living the events created by the Lord Jesus. We will assemble at St. Fanahan's Well at 7.15am and with lighted candles walk to the Church, contemplating the wonder of Jesus' Resurrection for 8.30am Mass. It should be a beautiful experience.

We will also hold the usual Penitential Rite with a number of Priests hearing Confession on Monday night at 7.30pm. This year one of the Servant Priests of the Home of the Mother will lead us. There will also be many other opportunities of Confession and Reconciliation during the week.

Let us all enter this week, with renewed devotion and hope. Let us honour the Lord Jesus.
